

Incident Report: Captain Lowan Skomantis

Oruach Severin, Combat Engineer of the 5th Legion was taken into custody along with his family on the third of the tenday by martian reckoning. Pending further investigation of his abilities and possible changes to his biology or access to unknown technologies – potentially all three – the legionary will be charged with involuntary manslaughter in the case of Specialist Byron Bravost.

The specialist was assaulted when he drew his sidearm after initial contact with survivors from the event at the Crimson Sanctum. It is not the place of this Captain to speculate on the nature of the event itself – though I can say the quantum connections throughout the area for connectivity to the galactic weave were in tatters. Our othermind K-9 unit could not be coaxed to leave the ship nor approach anywhere near the event without whining, whimpering, and mad barking and snarling.

Four survivors were found after multiple pulse rockets tore a hole in the edge of the event allowing us to move into the space without hindrance. I leave to the scientists the methods of interaction between pulse weaponry and the event as described. The four survivors were, Oruach Severin, his wife [REDACTED] Severin, and his son and daughter [REDACTED] Severin. All four survivors were unharmed, though Oruach's clothing had been destroyed as if burned away.

They were commanded to halt, but did not comply, the boy acting out and shouting in a language unknown to my men. Specialist Bravost [REDACTED] his weapon. The occurrences from then forward are difficult to explain. Oruach used some kind of advanced tech which could not be found on his person – leading us to believe [REDACTED]. He covered the distance of ten paces to Specialist Bravost in a fraction of a second. To my eyes it seemed he disappeared with a flash of light and re-appeared behind me. A flame covered his body of a series of colors which is difficult to describe. Upon grasping the Specialist's wrist, the flame began to burn away his magsuit exposing him to the elements. A thorough investigation of Oruach Severin failed to find the generator for the flame, but a more in-depth scan may be required. The likelihood that the whole family was specially and illegally engineered cannot be ruled out.

The manner of Specialist Bravost's death was almost certainly due to a lack of regular oxygen, exposure to the elements of Mars, and the produced fire from Oruach's hidden source. The magsuit, [REDACTED] burned away with ease. The Specialist's face flickered between visible and shadowed as the visual implants which reflected through the magsuits integrated

faceshield shorted from the burning of the legionary's fire. Whatever weaponry this is, it may be even more dangerous than [REDACTED] which produced the void event.
